

SENIOR SPECIAL AGENT JEFF ZLOTNICK

Senior Special Agent (SSA) Jeff Zlotnick has been an agent with the United States Secret Service since 2002. He started in the Los Angeles Field Office where he was assigned to the Bank Fraud Squad. When not on protective assignments, he was investigating stolen or counterfeited U.S. Treasury checks, counterfeit cashier's checks and other financial crimes. SSA Zlotnick then spent 2 ½ years on the U.S. Marshals' Fugitive Task Force working alongside other Federal, city and state law enforcement officers tracking down and arresting the top tier of most wanted fugitives and offenders in Los Angeles that had outstanding warrants for murder, violence, sex crimes and crimes against children. SSA Zlotnick was then assigned to the general Fraud Squad where he was involved in the training of new agents to the squad and investigating organized crime groups who were using stolen credit card information to buy gasoline in bulk then selling it at a discount on the black market. SSA Zlotnick spent 5 ½ years on the Vice Presidential Detail with Vice President Biden and then 3 years on a headquarters assignment before leaving Washington D.C. for the Las Vegas Field Office where he continues to investigate crimes regarding financial instruments and threats against U.S. Secret Service protectees.

Prior to joining the U.S. Secret Service, SSA Zlotnick graduated with a degree in Finance from Brigham Young University. He has worked at banks in New Mexico and Utah, worked in the Internal Auditing Department at BYU during his junior and senior years at the University, worked for an accounting firm in New Mexico and was the Comptroller of a marketing company in Utah before being hired by the U.S. Secret Service.
