**PURPOSE:** The Lola Belk Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to Automotive Personnel wishing to continue their education at the Annual ADOMA Conference and those with a financial need.

**Criteria:** Applicants eligible for assistance must be currently working in the automotive industry for at least 5 years and a current ADOMA member. Consideration will be given to individuals based on desire, financial need and commitment to attend the chapter meetings and fall conference or the summer conference. Letter of nomination from your peers (GM, BM, OM, Dealer, Colleague).

**Guidelines:** One Scholarship of your choice will be awarded in June. An award certificate will be sent to the recipient and he/she will automatically be signed up for his/her chosen event(s). The Award will be decided by the Executive Board.

**Amount:** The scholarship awarded will be valued up to \$1500.00.

**Deadline:** **The application deadline date is June 1, 2024.** The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted.
